U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS – The Virgin Islands Department of Human Services Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) would like to remind Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Households who received a Recertification Application Packet in the mail this month, that the completed packet must be returned as soon as possible, or before the date stated on the enclosed Notice of Expiration, to avoid interruption to your SNAP benefits on October 31, 2021.
