U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS - The Virgin Islands Department of Human Services (VIDHS), is advising the community that due to a broken 24' WAPA water mainline on the waterfront affecting downtown Charlotte Amalie, St. Thomas, the DHS Knud Hansen Complex will be closing this Wednesday, March 15, 2023, at 8:00am due to a lack of running water at the facilities
